An identical sculpture is located at Pasing's city hall. Twice a year the „Kulturforum München-West“ organizes a memorial in Pasing (in November) and in Obermenzing (in January) to remember the Jewish residents of our community who became victims of the holocaust. Our local history group *Jewish Life in Munich-West* participates in these events.
